**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF SOUTH PASADENA, CALIFORNIA,
MAKING CERTAIN FINDINGS AND REPEALING
THE CURRENT CHAPTER 14 (FIRE PREVENTION) AND
AMENDING THE SOUTH PASADENA MUNICIPAL CODE
TO ADD A NEW CHAPTER 14 (FIRE PREVENTION)
TO ADOPT BY REFERENCE AND AMEND
THE 2010 CALIFORNIA FIRE CODE**

The purpose of this ordinance is to adopt by reference and amend that certain code known as the California Fire Code (CFC), 2010 edition, as amended and adopted by the State of California, with certain amendments, additions, and deletions thereto to meet local climatic, topographical and geological conditions as well as to protect the public health, safety and welfare. The ordinance amends the South Pasadena Municipal Code by repealing there from Chapter 14 (Fire Prevention) and substituting a new Chapter 14 (Fire Prevention) in lieu thereof.

The forgoing Ordinance No. 2215 was adopted by the South Pasadena City on Wednesday, January 5, 2011, by the following vote:
